Science: Earth and Space: Students will focus on the observable changes that occur in the sky and landscape. Students explore how the Earth's resources are used and investigate their conservation.



Digital Technology: Communication & Sharing:

Stage 1 of the Digital Technologies strand focuses on digital systems and their components. Students investigate how digital systems display data and use a sequence of steps and decisions (algorithms) to solve problems. Stage 1 of this strand develops students' understanding of how digital systems use algorithms to communicate.



CAPA: Drama: This semester creative and performing arts will be covered during community languages time. The focus for this term will be drama.

Students explore and convey stories, events and feelings through roles and they work collaboratively to communicate and express feelings about the action of the drama. They experience and respond to a range of drama forms and elements by making, performing and appreciating drama.



PDHPE: Students will participate in weekly physical education lessons, focusing on Team Building.

Students will further engage in weekly health lessons learning to look after their own and others' health, safety and well-being.
