

## Year 2 Overview Term 2 2025

English	Year 2 students have continued to develop skills about context, narrative, character, perspective, symbolism, connotation and imagination.
Phonics	Each Year 2 class engages in daily phonics lessons. These lessons build their recognition of sight (camera) words and develop their recognition of graphemes in written language and grapheme/phoneme correspondence in oral language.
Mathematics	Time: reading the Gregorian calendar, understanding duration; commutative properties of addition; forming arrays; identifying and describing patterns; adding two- and three-digit numbers; comparing and classifying polygons; measuring area using informal units; measuring volume.
History	Students have continued investigating the natural and human features of places. They describe the reasons places change and identify the active role of citizens in the care of places. They learn about how people describe the weather and seasons of places. Students explore activities occurring in places and how the spaces within places can be used for different purposes.
Science	Students have continued to develop their understanding of how living things and their environment play a central role in the support for and survival of humans. They are learning about features of habitats and are also studying fish, mammals and birds.
CAPA	Students have continued to participate in Music and Visual Arts lessons in class and Drama and Dance lessons in Community Language and Cultural Awareness groups.
PE	Year 2 have been developing and practising Athletics Skills.
